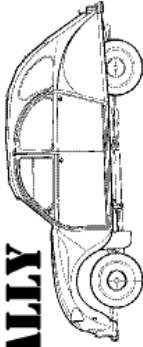

8 Location: Doon Hill Homestead (South of Dunbar) **Bonus Questions:** Answer the following questions. (8 pts each)

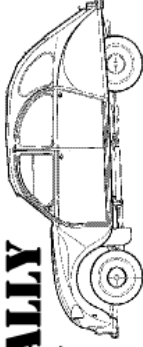

3 Location: The old town you leave in song (6) **Bonus Question:** In the vicinity of the cathedral, find the Bishop Cosin's Almshouses & Bishop Langley's Song & Grammar Schools. What dates are on the plaque? (13 pts)

4 Location: Adult male deer, meets playwright George Bernard (8) **Bonus Question:** At the "Errington Arms", you'll find a plaque about the Portgate. The two outposts forts at Risingham & High Rochester were occupied until at least the late part of what century (9 pts)

5 Location: 39th US president Jimmy. At the serving counter of a pub (6,3) **Bonus Question:** Who was the "Original Border Piper" and when did he die. (11 pts)
