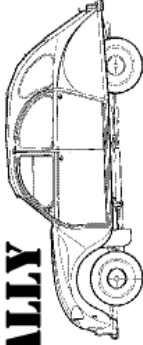

**Location:** Hardknott Roman Fort **Bonus Questions:** Answer the following questions: (8 pts each)

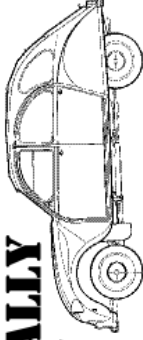

**Location:** William Shatner character James, in rock. Not fail (9.4) **Bonus Question:** What date and height ASL are depicted on the on sign of the Inn of the same name as this location? (14 pts)



**Location:** Trick money out of you, with abbreviated island, of a heavy weight (8) **Bonus Question:** Find the grave of "John Ruskin" and note what Buddhist symbol lies between the date he was born and the date he died. (15 pts)
